Craig Schreiner – Pine Lakes Country Club Architect President, Schreiner Golf, Inc.

Nationally-known golf course architect Craig Schreiner is overseeing the Pine Lakes golf restoration project and is committed to preserving many of the historical golf corridors that made Pine Lakes famous throughout the years. Schreiner will take Pine Lakes back to Robert White's original 1927 course design with a few technological improvements.

Schreiner, who collaborated with Nick Price on The Members Course at Grande Dunes Resort in Myrtle Beach in 2005, will utilize all inward nine holes from White's design, and create nine additional holes that match the style and look of the original course.

Schreiner has more than 20 years of experience as a golf course architect and has worked in all areas of the design, construction and maintenance of golf courses. He has directed the construction of 21 new courses in 13 states and managed the renovation and restoration of 28 courses in 11 states. He has served as a consultant to several championship courses in preparation for major tournaments including the 1995 Ryder Cup Matches, the 2004 U.S. Men's Amateur, the 1996 Curtis Cup and the NEC World Tour Championship.

Driven by a pure enthusiasm for the game of golf, Schreiner opened Schreiner Golf Inc. (SGI) in January of 1990, and he and his associates have provided a wide range of services including new course design; renovation - master planning; restoration - classic course improvement; site feasibility and land planning; landscape architecture - site planning; drainage and grading plans; turfgrass - environmental & wildlife factors; tree and landscape planting plans; history and research and educational seminars for professional development credits.

Before starting Schreiner Golf (SGI) in 1990, Schreiner worked as the Design Coordinator for the Hurdzan Design Group (1988-1990) and with former PGA professional, Don Sechrest, in Sechrest and Schreiner Golf Design (1985-1988).

Schreiner graduated from Ohio State University with an associate degree of applied science in turfgrass management after obtaining his bachelor of science degree in landscape architecture from Oregon State University.
